



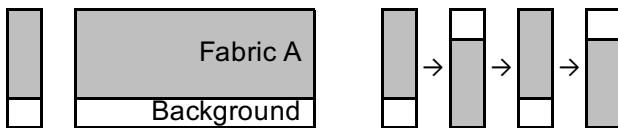
## Sidewalk Sampler

Finished Quilt Size: 40" x 56"

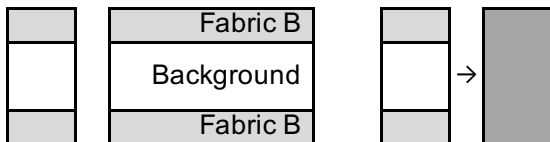
Finished Block Size: 8" x 8"

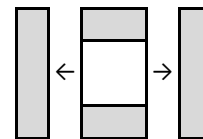
1. Make 1 Strip Set using 1 Fabric A 6 1/2" and 1 Background 2 1/2" strip. Cut 16 segments each 2 1/2". Sew 4 segments together as shown. Make 4 blocks.



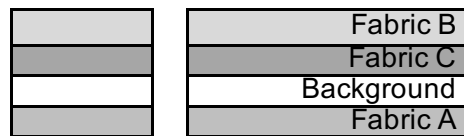
2. Make 1 Strip Set using 2 Fabric B 2 1/2" and 1 Background 4 1/2" strip. Cut 8 segments each 4 1/2". Sew Fabric C Sub-Cut 4 1/2" x 8 1/2" pieces to the side of 4 segments. Make 4 blocks. 4 remaining segments will be used in Step 3.



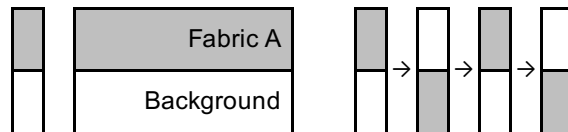
3. Sew Fabric B Sub-Cut 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" pieces to each side of the remaining 4 Step 2 segments. Make 4 blocks.



4. Make 1 Strip Set using 1 Fabric B, C, Background and A 2 1/2" strips. Cut 4 segments each 8 1/2".



5. Make 1 Strip Set using 1 Fabric A and 1 Background 4 1/2" strip. Cut 16 segments each 2 1/2". Sew 4 segments together as shown. Make 4 blocks.



6. For each of the 5 columns sew the 4 blocks from each step together as shown. Sew the columns together using the Background 2 1/2" strips as Sashing. Sew Fabric C 4 1/2" strips to sides and ends.
