"Charmed for Charity"



This simple one-patch quilt pattern is quick and easy and great for so many purposes.

- Teaches a beginner quilter the basics of piecing a quilt top including accurate $\frac{1}{4}$ " seams and matching seams.
- This is a great way to use up your scraps. When you finish a project, cut your remaining smaller scrap into 5" squares and store until you have enough for a quilt.
- This is an easy quilt to make as a group charity project. Gather your scraps and go!

Finished Size: 40.5" x 49.5"

Fabric Requirements:

Scrappy:	99 - 5" squares from scrap
Half Scrappy:	Cut 50 - 5" squares from scrap Cut 49 - 5" squares from Background Fabric
Two-Color:	Cut 50 - 5" squares from Fabric 1 Cut 49 - 5" squares from Fabric 2
Three-Color:	Cut 33 - 5" squares from 3 different fabrics
Diagonal:	Cut 49 - 5" squares from background fabric Cut 10 - 5" squares From 5 different fabrics

Sew: Layout as desired and sew into 11 rows of 9 squares as pictured.
