This quick and easy quilt uses 10" squares. Cutting two kits at a time increases fabric efficiency and reduces waste.

Two-Fabric Version

Fabric Requirements for Two Quilts:

Two-Fabric Version:
1 ½ yards Focus Fabric

****OR****

Scrappy Version:
20 - 10" squares

Plus:
1 ½ yards Background
1 yard border



Scrappy Version

Fabric/Cut: **directions in () is for two quilts*

Focus Fabric: 1 yard (1 ½ yard) Cut 3 (5) - 10" strips. Subcut to 10 (20) 10" squares
-OR- 10 (20) 10" squares from your scraps or a layer cake (or 5 FQs)

Background: 1 yard (1 ½ yard) Cut 3 (5) - 10" strips. Subcut to 10 (20) 10" squares

Border: ½ yard (3/4 yard) Cut 5(10) - 2 ½" strips.

Sew:

Draw a line diagonally on the wrong side of the background squares. Lay a 10" background square on top of a 10" focus/scrap square RST. Sew ¼" from each side of the line. Cut each block unit on the diagonal line.

Press each HST towards the focus/scrap fabric. Complete 20 (40) blocks in this manner. Trim blocks to 9 ½" square.

Arrange blocks as shown and sew together. Add the border.
