







Fabric C	1/2 yard or 13 inches	1	4½" x WOF

Fabric D	1/4 yard or 6 1/2 inches	1	6½" x WOF	16	2½" x 6½"


1. Make 1 Strip Set using 1 Fabric A 4½" and 1 Fabric B 2½" strip. Cut 16 segments each 2½".




2. Make 1 Strip Set using 1 Fabric A 2½" and 1 Fabric C 4½" strip. Cut 16 segments each 2½".




3. Sew Fabric A 2½" x 6½" piece, the Step 1 and 2 segments and Fabric D 2½" x 6½" piece as shown. Then sew Fabric C 2½" x 8½" piece to the bottom. Make 16 blocks.



4. Sew 4 of the Step 3 blocks together as shown. Using 2 Fabric A 2½" strips sew a Border around the 4 blocks.



5. Sew a Step 3 block to each side of a Fabric A 4½" x 8½" piece as shown. Make 4 units.



6. Sew two Step 3 blocks to each side of a Step 5 unit as shown, iron away from the center. Sew two Step 5 units to each side of the Step 4 center block as shown, iron toward the center. Sew last 2 Step 3 blocks to each side of the last Step 5 unit, iron away from the center. Sew the 3 rows together and use the Fabric A 2½" strips to add Borders to the ends and sides.
