
## Fast & Fun Half 'N Half Split



1. Make 18 half-square triangle units as shown using 6%" squares cut from the Theme Print and Fabric A.


Quilt Size: 41½" x 41½"




2. Make 4 Strip Sets. Cut 36 segments, each 3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" wide.




3. Join 2 segments to make a four-patch unit. Make 18 units.




4. Make 9 blocks.



5. Press the final seam up in 6 of the blocks and down in the remaining 3.



 Arrange the blocks in 3 rows of 3 blocks each. Join the blocks in horizontal rows. Join the rows. Add borders to the sides, you can use the partial seam method.
