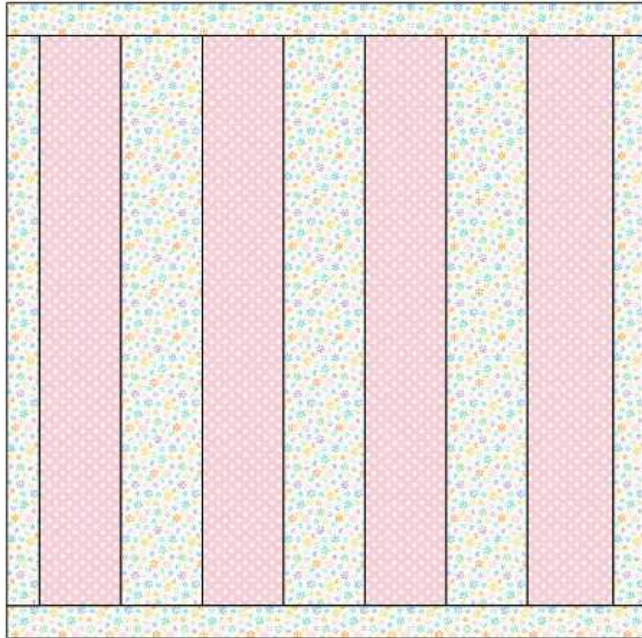


# Baby Strips

Sometimes simple is just what you need—especially when time is short and a baby needs a quilt! **Baby Strips** is made with easy vertical strips, making it a quick and satisfying project for any skill level.

Want extra softness? Try flannel for the top and minky on the back for the ultimate cuddle factor. Whether you go bold with prints or soft and soothing tones, this quilt is perfect for gifting, snuggling, or keeping on hand for the next new arrival.

**Finished Size: 39" x 39"**

## **Fabric:**

Fabric A (pink):	5/8 yard	Cut 4 - 5 1/2" strips
Fabric B (floral)/Border:	1 yard	Cut 3 - 5 1/2" strips
		Cut 4 - 2 1/2" strips

## **Sew:**

Sew Fabric A and Fabric B strips together, starting with Fabric A and alternating. Press. Trim to 35 1/2".

Add the border.

## **Quilt:**

To quilt on your domestic sewing machine, create a quilt sandwich by laying out the backing wrong side up, batting, and the quilt top right side up. Pin baste or use your preferred method to secure the layers. Using your machine's foot as a guide, quilt on either side of the seams about 1/4" and all around the border seams.

Bind the quilt by machine for a durable finish.
