



Covered In Spirit



Covered in Spirit celebrates the heart of scrap quilting, turning leftover 2½" strips into something warm, vibrant, and full of character. Its generous size makes it an ideal Project Linus quilt—especially for older kids who will appreciate its cheerful, spirited design.

Finished Size: 46" x 62"

Fabric/Cut:

SCRAPS: 140 - 2 ½" x 6 ½" rectangles

Background: ½ yard Cut 9 - 2 ½" strips Subcut into 140 - 2 ½" squares

Inner Border: ½ yard Cut 6 - 1 ½" strips


Border: ½ yard Cut 6 - 2 ½" strips

Sew:

Sew a background square to the end of each scrap strip.

Sew four units together as shown to form a block. Make 35 blocks.

Blocks should measure 8 ½".



Make 35
Unfinished size: 8 ½"

Choose your layout. Sew blocks into rows of five blocks. Sew rows together.

Quilt and bind.
