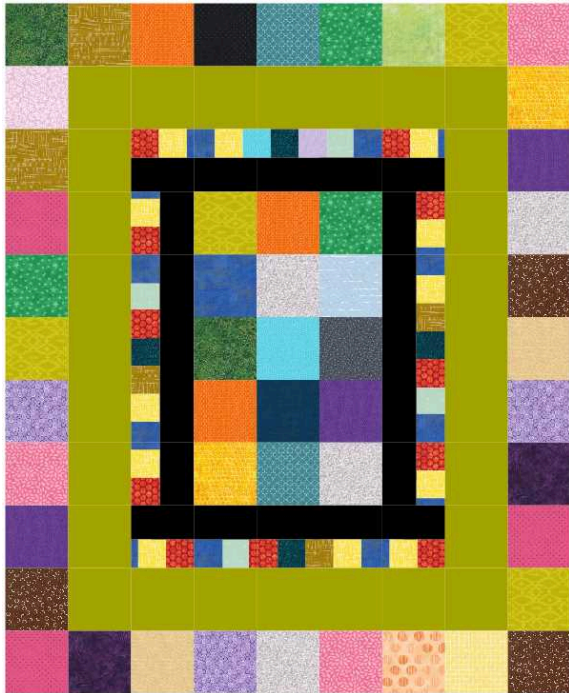


Covered In Scraps



I try to cut my scraps up into usable pieces so I can just pull my cut fabric when I am ready to make a quilt. This quilt will use your 5" squares and your 2 ½" squares.

The consistent sashing/borders gives a place to rest your eyes from all the scrap. Have fun with colors and don't be afraid to mix up your scraps in the same quilt.

Finished Size: 40.5" x 49.5"

Fabric/Cut:

From scraps: 51- 5" squares and 48- 2 ½" squares

Inner border (black): 4 - 23" x 2 ¾" (⅓ yard)

Outer border (green): 4 - 32" x 5" (⅝ yard)

Sew:

Sew center section with 5" squares (5 rows of 3 squares).

For the first border, sew four sections of 12 - 2 ½" squares. Sew these pieces onto the inner border strip (black). Trim if needed to make 23" x 5" sections. Sew these sections onto the center section.

Sew Outer border. (green).

For a scrappy final border, sew 4 sections of 9 - 5" squares. Sew these on to complete the quilt top.

(Tip: Because of all the seams exposed on the edges, stitch around the quilt at about ⅛" from the end to ensure the seams stay intact until it can be quilted.)
