


Covered In Playfulness



This two-rail rail fence pattern can be done using all scraps or by using the same fabric consistently as one of the rails and a scrappy variety in the other rail (as pictured).

This one was cut using a AccuQuilt die for $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles.

Finished Size: 45" x 57"



Fabric/Cutting:

Rail 1: 48 - $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " from scraps

Rail 2: 1 yard Cut 8 - 3.5" strips.

Subcut into 48 $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles

(For the Scrappy version, cut 96 - $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " from scraps and use it for rail 1 and rail 2.)

Borders:

Border 1 - $\frac{1}{3}$ yard

Cut 5 - 2" strips

Border 2 - $\frac{3}{4}$ yard

Cut 6 - $3\frac{1}{2}$ " strips

Sew:

Sew Rail 1 fabric to Rail 2 fabric. Make 48 units/blocks. Sew these blocks into 8 rows of 6 blocks, alternating direction as pictured above.

Add borders.
