


Covered In Peace



Fabric:

Sashing: 1 yard
Scraps: 48 - 5" squares
Border: 1/2 yard



Cut:

Sashing: Cut 14 - 2" strips With 6 strips, subcut into 48- 5" pieces
 With 8 strips, subcut into 48 - 6 1/2 " pieces
Border: Cut 5 - 2 1/2" strips

Sew:

Sew a 5" sashing strip to the top of each 5" scrap block. Sew a 6 1/2" sashing strip to the right side of each 5" block. Make 48 blocks.

Layout as shown. Sew together. Add the border.

Covered in Peace is a great charm quilt to have in your pattern rotation. This quilt goes together quickly and uses up lots of those 5" squares in your scrap stash.

Sashing strips are usually a consistent color but try to alternate the sashing using two contrasting fabrics such as black and white.

To use a charm pack for this quilt, make 40 blocks instead of 48.

Finished Size: 43" x 56"
