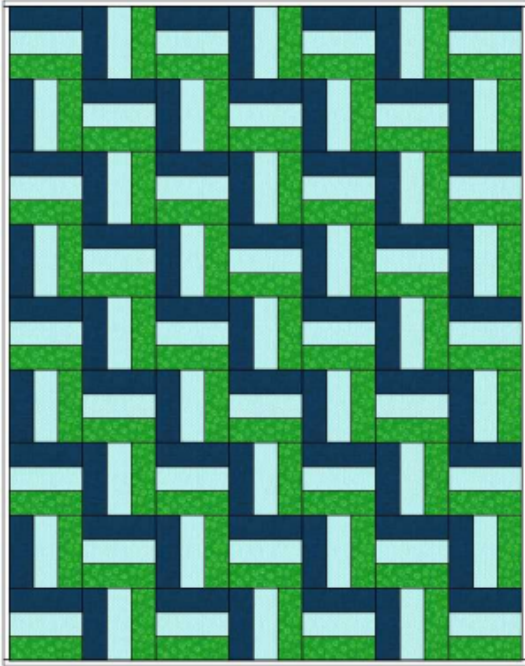


Covered In Smiles

Perfect for a 3 yard bundle



3 yard quilts are very popular right now. This is one that is in that category. For a little less than a yard of three fabrics, you have this fun quilt that will bring smiles to kids! You will want to consider contrast in selecting your fabrics.

If all three fabrics read the same tone and color it may not get the zig-zag effect you want. Mixing solids/tone-on-tone with different size designs will make the quilt more interesting. If it is pleasing to you, it is going to be an awesome quilt!

Finished Size: 42" x 54"

Fabric Requirements:

- 7/8 yards of three coordinating fabrics.

Cut:

- 11 - 2 ½" strips from each fabric.

Sew:

- Using one strip of each color, sew into 11 strip sets. Press seams to one side.
- Cut strip sets into 6 ½" sections (or width of strip set). You will need 63 blocks.
- Layout and sew together into 9 rows of 11 blocks. Refer to the picture above.
