

Fast & Fun Chameleon Block

Quilt Size: 40½" x 40½"

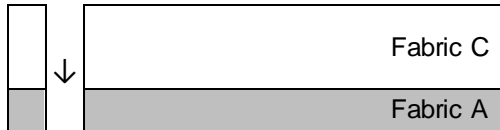
Finished Block Size: 6" x 6"

Fabric	Yardage	# of Strips	Strip Size
Fabric A	5/8 yd. or 17 1/2 inches	7	2½" x 42"
Fabric B	5/8 yd. or 18 1/2 inches	2	2½" x 42"
		3	4½" x 42"
Fabric C	5/8 yd. or 18 1/2 inches	2	2½" x 42"
		3	4½" x 42"
Border	1/3 yd. or 10 inches	4	2½" x 42"

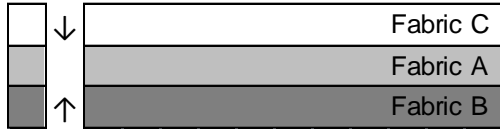
1. Make 2 full strip sets and an additional 11" strip set using Fabric A 2½" and Fabric B 4½" strips. Iron towards Fabric A. Cut 36 2½" segments.



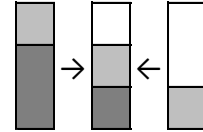
2. Make 2 full strip sets and an additional 11" strip set using Fabric C 4½" and Fabric A 2½" strips. Iron towards Fabric A. Cut 36 2½" segments.



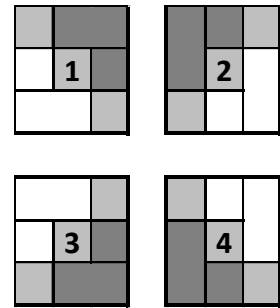
3. Make 2 full strip sets using Fabric C, A and B 2½" strips. Then using scraps from Steps 1 and 2 – create a 11" strip set. Iron towards Fabric A. Cut 36 2½" segments.



4. Using Step 1, 2 & 3 segments make 36 blocks as shown.



5. You'll be using the same block in 4 different orientations, so I've labeled each here to be used in the layouts below.



6. Arrange blocks based on 1 of 2 layouts shown or make up your own layout. Add borders to tops and sides.
