

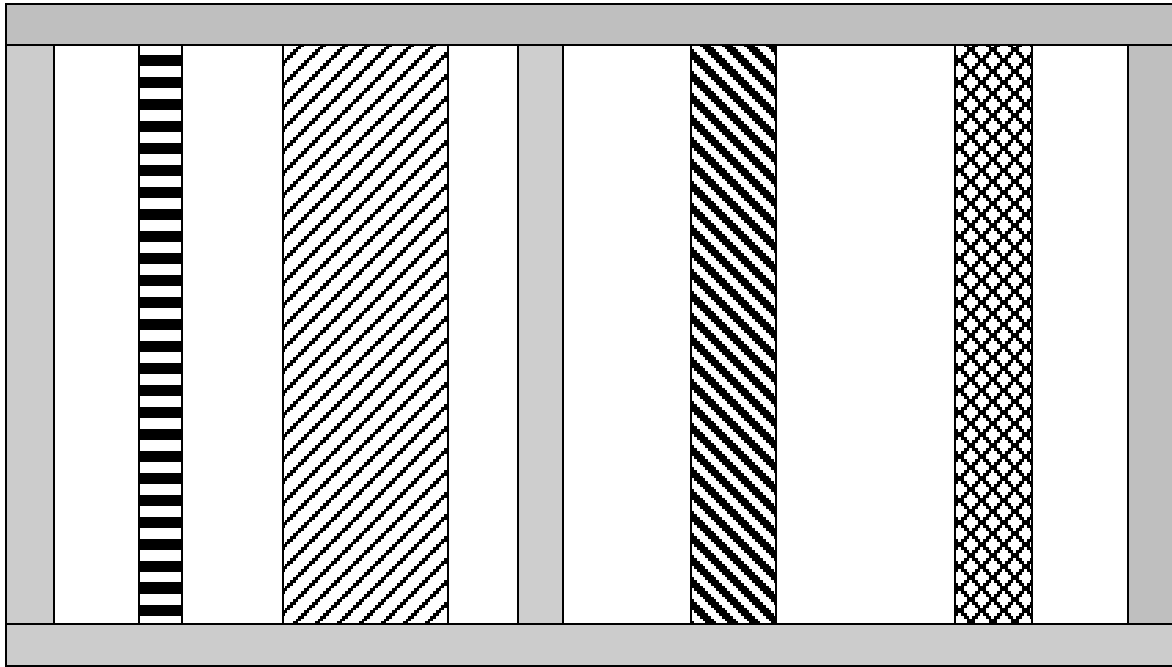
Fast & Fun Simple Strips

Quilt Size: around 45 x 60"

Fabric	Yardage	#	Strip Size
Strips	Scraps		Any size x WOF
Border	3/8 yd or 12.5 inches	5	2½ x WOF

WOF = Width of Fabric

Collect a set of scrap strips that are at least 40 inches long. Add the width of each strip minus ½ inch (for seam allowances) until the total is about 55 inches. Arrange fabrics and sew strips together as shown below. Trim the selvages and even the edges based on the shortest strip. Add borders.

If you want to add some additional visual interest, after sewing the strips together and before you add the border, cut down the length of the strip in 1 or 2 places and then reverse the strips. See examples below. Note: don't make the strips symmetrical if you plan to do one of the following.
