

Fast & Fun Sew Square Pinwheel

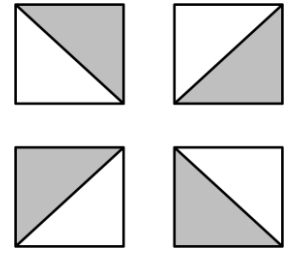
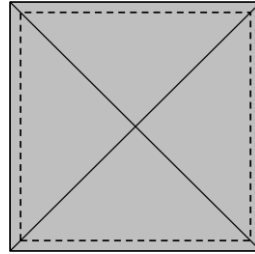
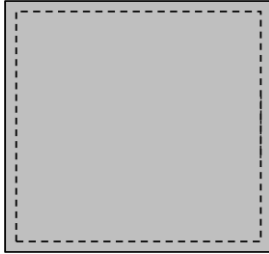
Block Size: approx. 13" x 13"

Quilt Size: 38½" x 53½"

Fabric	Yardage	# of Strips	Strip Size	2 nd Cut	Square Size	# of Squares
Theme Print	5/8 yd. or 20 inches	2	10" x WOF	Cut 10" squares from strips	10" x 10"	6
Note: for the kits I was able to use 6 different Theme Print fabrics so each pinwheel block would be unique						
Background	1 1/8 yd. or 37½ inches	2	10" x WOF	Cut 10" squares from strips	10" x 10"	6
		7	2½" x WOF			
Border	5/8 yd. or 17½ inches	5	3½" x WOF			

WOF = Width of Fabric

- With right sides together, match up each 10" Theme Print fabric square to a 10" Background square. Sew a ¼" seam all the way around overlapping the beginning. Repeat for all 6 'square sets'.
- Cut each sewn 'square set' across both diagonals. Iron each ½ square triangle block open.
- Sew each set of 4 blocks created in Step 2 into a pinwheel arranged as shown. Make 6 pinwheel blocks.



- Using background fabric 2½" strips, add sashing and inner border as shown, then add outer border.
