
Fast & Fun **Sew Square Pinwheel**



WOF = Width of Fabric


With right sides together, match up each 10" Theme 1. Print fabric square to a 10" Background square. Sew a 1/4" seam all the way around overlapping the beginning. Repeat for all 6 'square sets'.




2. Cut each sewn 'square set' across both diagonals. Iron each 1/2 square triangle block open.



Sew each set of 4 blocks created 3. in Step 2 into a pinwheel arranged as shown. Make 6 pinwheel blocks.





Using background fabric 21/2" strips, add sashing and inner border as shown, then add outer border. 4.
