

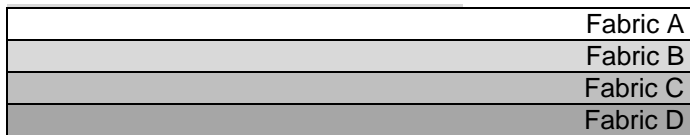
Fast & Fun Riding the Rails

Quilt Size: 38" x 50"

Finished Block Size: 6" x 6"

Fabric	Yardage	# of Strips	Strip Size
Fabric A	3/8 yd. or 8 inches	4	2" x 42"
Fabric B	3/8 yd. or 8 inches	4	2" x 42"
Fabric C	3/8 yd. or 8 inches	4	2" x 42"
Fabric D	3/8 Yd. or 8 inches	4	2" x 42"
Inner Border	3/8 Yd. or 8 inches	4	2" x 42"
Outer Border	3/4 yd. or 24 inches	4	6" x 42"

1. Make 4 identical strip sets as shown. Press all seams toward the darker fabrics.

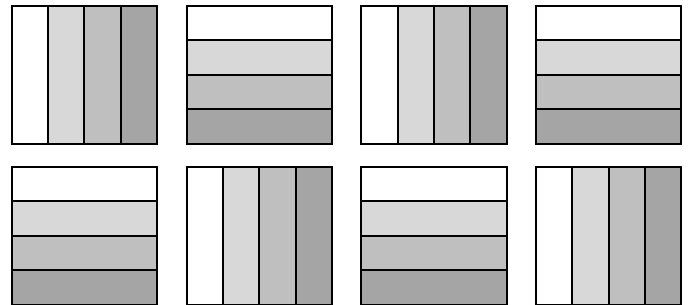

2. Crosscut the strip sets into 24 squares, each 6½" x 6½".
* Measure the width of the strip set before cutting, if it's not 6½" wide, then crosscut your strip sets into squares using the width of your strip set.



3. Arrange the blocks (first 2 rows shown below). Sew the blocks together in horizontal rows. Press the seams in opposite directions from row to row.



4. Add the inner and outer borders as shown below.
