


Covered In Speckles



Sometimes you need a project to work on in between projects. This is one of those.

Cut out 2" squares from project leftovers and keep by your sewing machine. Grab two to sew together as leader or enders. Then sew the pairs together to make a strip of four squares. Next, sew the fours together to make your strips of eight squares. When you have a decent pile, start making the blocks with your 2" strips. Before you know it, you will have a quilt.

Finished Size: 48" x 60"

Fabric/Cut:

640 - 2" squares Scraps! If you have a scrap storage system with a 2" bucket, get it out.

From 20 different fabrics, cut 4 - 12 ½" x 2" strips

For each block (Make 20 blocks):

Sew 8 - 2" squares together. Make four per block.

Sew the scrap strips together with a solid strip as shown.

Sew:

Sew blocks together four across and five rows. Pay attention to the direction of the blocks on alternating rows.
