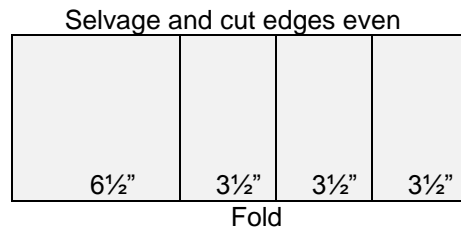


Fast & Fun Fat Quarter Fiesta

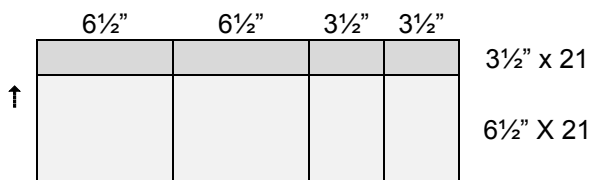
Quilt Size: 42" x 51"

Finished Block Size: 9" x 9"

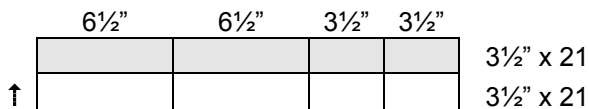
Fabric	Yardage	No. of Strips	Strip Size
6 Fat Quarters (18 x 22)	At Least 17 x 21 inches	1	6½" x 21-22"
		3	3½" x 21-22"
Borders	½ yd.	5	3½" x Fabric Width



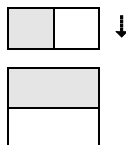
1. Make three sets as shown in a variety of combinations using one 3½" strip and one 6½" strip for each set. Sets should measure 9½" x 21". Cut two 6½" units and two 3½" units from each set.



2. Make four sets as shown below in a variety of combinations using two 3½" strips for each set. Sets should measure 6½" x 21". Cut two 6½" units and two 3½" units from each set.



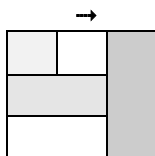
3. Stitch the 6½" and 3½" Step 2 units together as shown in a variety of combinations. The resulting units should measure 6½" x 9½".



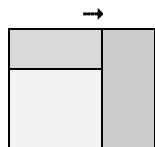
4. Cut each remaining 3½" strip into two 9½" x 3½" units.



5. Stitch Step 3 units and Step 4 rectangles together to make 8 blocks (there will be leftover rectangles). The blocks should measure 9½" x 9½".



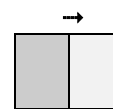
6. Stitch the leftover rectangles to the 6½" Step 1 units to make 6 blocks. The blocks should measure 9½" x 9½".



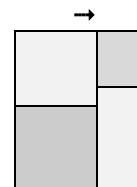
7. Cut each remaining 6½" strip into four 5" units.



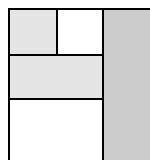
8. Stitch the Step 7 units together along the long edge into a variety of pairs. The resulting pairs should measure 6½" x 9½".



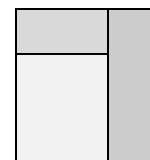
9. Stitch the 3½" Step 1 units to the Step 8 pairs in a variety of combinations to make 6 blocks. The blocks should measure 9½" x 9½".



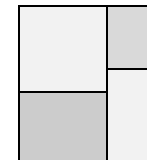
You now have a total of 20 blocks, each 9½" x 9½"

Arrange blocks in a random, pleasing order, turning blocks as needed. Stitch into 5 rows of 4 blocks each. Add borders to top and bottom. Join strips at the ends as needed to make side borders.
